Sub: Grant of conditional permission to the **Prakash Institute of Ayurvedic Medical Sciences and Research, Jhhjar, Bulendshehar, Uttar Pradesh** with **60 seats in UG (BAMS) course** under Section 13A of the IMCC Act, 1970 for the academic session 2018-19– reg.

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to refer to the Ministry's order No.R.12011/48/2015-EP (IM-1) for 2017-18 dated 08.08.2017 related to admission matter for the year 2017-18 intimating to develop the requisite infrastructure for 3rd professional for consideration of the case for the 2018-19 sessions.

2. The CCIM had carried out an inspection of the institution on 07.02.2018 and re-visited on 28-29.05.2018 to reassess the available facilities of teaching and practical training as well as to verify the compliance submitted by the college and forwarded its recommendations and report to the Ministry. On examining the same, it was observed that the Web based computerized central registration system, Yoga Teacher, Quality testing laboratory, Operation theatre, X-ray, ECG & USG, College website and Aadhaar based Geo location enabled attendance system for teaching staff, non-teaching staff, hospital staff were not available. Therefore, under provisions of the first proviso to sub-section (5) of Section 13A of the IMCC Act, 1970, an opportunity of hearing was granted to the college on 14.08.2018 to present the case.

3. The observation of hearing Committee based on submission made by the college representatives during hearing and recommendations & visitation report of the CCIM have been carefully examined in terms of the “Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016, provisions under the IMCC Act, 1970, relevant regulations made thereunder and as per approved Standard Operative Procedures (SOPs) for the UG/PG

course(s) for consideration of grant of conditional permission for UG (BAMS) course, it is found that College is fulfilling criterion for granting conditional permission for UG (BAMS).

4. It has been decided by the Central Government to **grant of conditional permission** to the "Prakash Institute of Ayurvedic Medical Sciences and Research, Jhhjar, Bulendshehar, Uttar Pradesh" with **60 seats in UG (BAMS) course**, for the academic session 2018-19 under Section 13A of the IMCC Act, 1970, **subject to the condition that college shall fulfill the deficiencies as mentioned below by 31st December, 2018:**

- (i) Web based computerized central registration system in the hospital.
- (ii) Quality testing laboratory in the college.
- (iii) USG facility in the hospital.
- (iv) Aadhaar based Geo location enabled attendance system for teaching staff, non-teaching staff, hospital staff as per RMS, 2016.

5. In addition, following requirements should be fulfilled by the college by 31st December, 2018 to get conditional permission for the session 2019-20:

- (i) all the Requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016;
- (ii) all the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standards of Education in Indian Medicine) Amendment Regulations, 2016 (for Ayurveda); and
- (iii) all the requirements under the provisions of the IMCC Act, 1970 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled *in toto*.

5. The fulfillment of the conditions attached to the permission given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted to the Ministry of AYUSH endorsing a copy to the CCIM also. The CCIM will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled by means of an inspection and submit a report in this matter to the Ministry of AYUSH for considering the permission matter from the academic session 2019-20.
